- 9 wine and beer retailer's permit is \$175.
- 10 (b) For a wine and beer retailer's permit for a premises
- 11 located in a county with a population of 1.4 million or more, the
- 12 state fee is:
- 13 (1) \$1,000 for an original permit; and
- 14 (2) \$750 annually for a renewal permit.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 69.02, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 69.02. FEE. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b)
- 18 or [in] Section 69.03 [of this code], the annual state fee for a
- 19 retail dealer's on-premise license is \$150.
- 20 (b) For a retail dealer's on-premise license for a premises
- 21 located in a county with a population of 1.4 million or more, the

SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
to an application for an original or renewal wine and beer
retailer's permit or retail dealer's on-premise license filed on or
after the effective date of this Act. An application filed before
the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect
immediately before that date, and that law is continued in effect
for that purpose.
