A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the transfer of public school students who are the 3 victims of bullying.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 25, Education Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 25.0341 to read as follows:
- Sec. 25.0341. TRANSFER OF VICTIMS OF BULLYING. (a) In this
- 8 <u>section, "bullying" means engaging in written or verbal expression</u>
- 9 or physical conduct that:
- 10 <u>(1) the student knows or reasonably believes will</u>
 11 cause significant emotional distress to another student;
- 12 <u>(2) causes significant emotional distress to another</u>
 13 student; and
- 14 <u>(3) would cause significant emotional distress to a</u>
 15 <u>reasonable person under the same circumstances.</u>
- 16 <u>(b) On the request of a parent or other person with</u>
 17 <u>authority to act on behalf of a student who is a victim of bullying,</u>
- 18 <u>the board of trustees of a school district shall transfer the victim</u>
- 19 <u>to:</u>

- (1) another classroom at the campus to which the
- 21 victim was assigned at the time the bullying occurred; or
- 22 (2) a campus in the school district other than the
- 23 campus to which the victim was assigned at the time the bullying
- occurred.

- 1 (c) The board of trustees shall verify that a student has
- been a victim of bullying before transferring the student under
- 3 this section.
- 4 (d) Section 25.034 does not apply to a transfer under this
- 5 <u>section.</u>
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
