- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 25.081, Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 25.081. OPERATION OF SCHOOLS. (a) Except as
- 8 authorized under Subsection (b) of this section, Section 25.084, or
- 9 Section 29.0821, for each school year each school district must
- operate so that the district provides for not more than [at least]
- 11 180 days and not fewer than 1,260 hours of instruction for students.
- 12 (b) The commissioner may approve the instruction of
- 13 students for fewer than the number of hours [days] required under
- 14 Subsection (a) if disaster, flood, extreme weather conditions, fuel
- 15 curtailment, or another calamity causes the closing of schools.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2005-2006
- 17 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
