4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 7, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 7.008 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 7.008. STATEWIDE STUDENT ENROLLMENT, ATTENDANCE, AND
8	ACHIEVEMENT TRACKING SYSTEM. (a) Each school district shall
9	participate in a system meeting standards approved by the
10	commissioner to track each student enrolled in a public school in
11	this state. A student tracking system must:
12	(1) produce detailed reports for agency officials and
13	policymakers and update information on each student's:
14	(A) enrollment;
15	(B) attendance;
16	(C) achievement, including course or grade
17	completion and assessment instrument results; and
18	(D) if applicable, specific reason for leaving a
19	school or school district, such as transferring, graduating, or
20	dropping out of school; and
21	(2) to facilitate the electronic transfer of student
22	records and the evaluation and improvement of educational programs
23	in the state, permit an authorized state or district official to
24	electronically retrieve information about a particular student as

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1 <u>necessary.</u>

2 (b) Each school district shall use the student tracking 3 system.

4 (c) The commissioner may solicit and accept grant funds to
5 maintain the student tracking system and to make the system
6 available to school districts.

7 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2006-20078 school year.

9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
