- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 32.024, Human Resources Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Subsection (w-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (w-1) Subject to Subsection (w) and the availability of
- 8 funds, the department may set a personal needs allowance described
- 9 by Subsection (w) in an amount not to exceed \$60. This subsection
- 10 expires September 1, 2007.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 32.024(w-1), Human Resources Code, as
- 12 added by this Act, applies to a personal needs allowance paid on or
- 13 after the effective date of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 15 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 16 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 17 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
