A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT 1 2 relating to the removal of a member of a junior college district 3 board of trustees for failure to attend board meetings. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 130, Education Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 130.0845 to read as follows: Sec. 130.0845. REMOVAL OF TRUSTEE FOR NONATTENDANCE OF 7 BOARD MEETINGS. (a) It is a ground for removal of a member of the 8 9 board of trustees of a junior college district that the member is absent from more than half of the regularly scheduled board 10 11 meetings that the member is eligible to attend during a calendar 12 year, not counting an absence for which the member is excused by a maj<u>ority vote of the board.</u> 13 14 (b) The validity of an action of the board of trustees is not affected by the fact that the action is taken when a ground for 15 16 removal of a member of the board exists. (c) A member of a board of trustees may be removed for a 17 ground provided by this section, using the procedures provided by 18 Subchapter B, Chapter 87, Local Government Code, for removing a 19 county official. 20 21 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to an individual who is elected or appointed to the board of trustees of a 22 23 junior college district before, on, or after the effective date of 24 this Act.
