BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 130, Education Code, is amended by adding Section 130.0845 to read as follows: 1-12 1-13 Sec. 130.0845. REMOVAL OF TRUSTEE FOR NONATTENDANCE OF BOARD MEETINGS. (a) It is a ground for removal of a member of the board of trustees of a junior college district that the member is absent from more than half of the regularly scheduled board 1-14 1**-**15 1**-**16 1-17 meetings that the member is eligible to attend during a calendar 1-18 year, not counting an absence for which the member is excused by a 1-19 1-20 1-21 majority vote of the board.

(b) The validity of an action of the board of trustees is not 1-22 affected by the fact that the action is taken when a ground for 1-23 removal of a member of the board exists. (c) A member of a board of trustees may be removed for 1-24 ground provided by this section, using the procedures provided by Subchapter B, Chapter 87, Local Government Code, for removing a 1-25 1-26

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to an individual who is elected or appointed to the board of trustees of a junior college district before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
