A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to creation of a program to provide for timely replacement
3	of child protective services caseworkers.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 40, Human Resources Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 40.0322 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 40.0322. CASEWORKER REPLACEMENT PROGRAM. (a) In this
8	section:
9	(1) "Caseworker" means a full-time department
10	employee who is a child protective services specialist.
11	(2) "Training academy" means a training academy that
12	trains caseworkers for the department.
13	(b) To the extent that funding is available, the department
14	shall develop a program to provide for the timely replacement of
15	caseworkers with trainees hired in anticipation of vacancies.
16	(c) In developing the program, the department shall:
17	(1) consider the turnover rate for caseworkers by
18	region; and
19	(2) to the extent that funding is available, maintain
20	the number of trainers and other necessary training academy
21	positions in each training academy at a level necessary to train new

caseworkers.

(d) Not later than December 31 of each even-numbered year,

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- of the house of representatives, and the presiding officer of each
- 2 house and senate standing committee having jurisdiction over
- 3 children's protective services a report regarding the program
- 4 required by this section. The report must include an assessment of:
- 5 (1) the effect of the program on retaining or timely
- 6 replacing caseworkers in each service region;
- 7 (2) whether there is a continuing need for the
- 8 program;
- 9 (3) the amount of funding necessary to fully
- 10 administer the program during the next biennium; and
- 11 (4) whether additional legislation is necessary to
- 12 address the need for caseworkers throughout this state or in
- 13 particular service regions.
- 14 SECTION 2. Unless sufficient funds are not available, the
- 15 Department of Family and Protective Services shall develop the
- program required by Section 40.0322, Human Resources Code, as added
- 17 by this Act, not later than December 31, 2005.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
