- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 662, Government Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 662.051 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 662.051. TEJANO HERITAGE DAY. (a) May 5, also known
- 7 as "Cinco de Mayo," is Tejano Heritage Day to commemorate the
- 8 history of Tejanos and the contributions Tejanos have made to the
- 9 State of Texas and the world.
- 10 (b) Tejano Heritage Day shall be regularly observed, in
- 11 concert with other notable historical celebrations, by appropriate
- 12 programs and activities in the public schools and other places to
- 13 <u>inspire greater appreciation of the history of Tejanos and the</u>
- 14 important contributions Tejanos have made to the State of Texas and
- 15 the world.
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
