A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to designating May 5 as Tejano Heritage Day.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. This Act may be cited as the Jesus Bazan/Antonio
- 5 Longoria Act.
- 6 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 662, Government Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 662.051 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 662.051. TEJANO HERITAGE DAY. (a) May 5, also known
- 9 as "Cinco de Mayo," is Tejano Heritage Day to commemorate the
- 10 <u>history of Tejanos and the contributions Tejanos have made to the</u>
- 11 State of Texas and the world.
- 12 (b) Tejano Heritage Day shall be regularly observed, in
- 13 concert with other notable historical celebrations, by appropriate
- 14 programs and activities in the public schools and other places to
- 15 inspire greater appreciation of the history of Tejanos and the
- 16 important contributions Tejanos have made to the State of Texas and
- 17 the world.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
