1-8 relating to the disclosure of certain information provided on a
1-9 voter registration application.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 13.004, Election Code, is
1-12 amended to read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 13.004. RECORDING AND DISCLOSURE OF CERTAIN
1-14 INFORMATION [~~TELEPHONE, SOCIAL SECURITY, DRIVER'S LICENSE, OR~~
1-15 ~~PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION NUMBER~~] BY REGISTRAR.

1-16 SECTION 2. Section 13.004, Election Code, is amended by
1-17 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

1-18 (d) The voter registrar or other county official who has
1-19 access to the information furnished on a registration application
1-20 may not post the following information on a website:

1-21 (1) a telephone number;

1-22 (2) a social security number;

1-23 (3) a driver's license number or a number of a personal
1-24 identification card; or

1-25 (4) a date of birth.

1-26 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-28 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-29 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-30 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
