Section 22.02(b), Penal Code, is amended to read 4 5 as follows: (b) An offense under this section is a felony of the second 6 degree, except that the offense is a felony of the first degree if: 7 (1) the actor uses a deadly weapon during the 8 commission of the assault and causes serious bodily injury to 9 another, including the person's spouse; or 10 (2) regardless of whether the offense is committed 11 12 under Subsection (a)(1) or (a)(2), the offense is committed: (A) [(1)] by a public servant acting under color 13 14 of the servant's office or employment; (B) [(2)] against a person the actor knows is a 15 public servant while the public servant is lawfully discharging an 16 official duty, or in retaliation or on account of an exercise of 17 official power or performance of an official duty as a public 18 19 servant; (C) [(3)] in retaliation against or on account of 20 21 the service of another as a witness, prospective witness, informant, or person who has reported the occurrence of a crime; or 22 23 (D) [(4)] against a person the actor knows is a security officer while the officer is performing a duty as a 24

1 security officer.

2 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 3 4 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 5 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of 6 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of 7 this Act if any element of the offense was committed before that 8 date. 9
