5	SECTION 1. Subchapter K, Chapter 547, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 547.615 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 547.615. MOBILE INFRARED TRANSMITTER PROHIBITED. (a)
8	In this section, "mobile infrared transmitter" means a device that
9	emits an infrared beam with the capability of changing a
10	traffic-control signal out of sequence.
11	(b) A person may not possess a mobile infrared transmitter.
12	(c) This section does not apply to possession of a mobile
13	infrared transmitter by a person in connection with official
14	operation of:
15	(1) an authorized emergency vehicle; or
16	(2) a transit vehicle operated by an authority under
17	Chapter 451 or 452 or a transit department under Chapter 453.
18	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
