BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter K, Chapter 547, Transportation Code, 5 is amended by adding Section 547.615 to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 547.615. MOBILE INFRARED TRANSMITTER PROHIBITED. (a) 8 In this section, "mobile infrared transmitter" means a device that emits an infrared beam with the capability of changing a 9 traffic-control signal out of sequence. 10 (b) A person may not possess a mobile infrared transmitter. 11 12 (c) This section does not apply to possession of a mobile 13 infrared transmitter by a person in connection with official 14 operation of an authorized emergency vehicle. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005. 15
