A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the required use of towing safety chains on certain 3 vehicles.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 545.410(a), Transportation Code, is 6 amended to read as follows:

7 (a) An operator of a passenger car or light truck may not draw a trailer, semitrailer, house trailer, or another motor 8 vehicle unless safety chains of a type approved by the department 9 are attached in a manner approved by the department from the 10 trailer, semitrailer, house trailer, or drawn motor vehicle to the 11 drawing vehicle. This subsection does not apply to the drawing of 12 13 equipment [a trailer or semitrailer] used for agricultural purposes 14 and for which registration is not required.

15 SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies 16 only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this 17 Act. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed before 18 the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs 19 before that date.

(b) An offense committed before the effective date of this
Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed,
and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
