1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the service area of the Blinn College District.
1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-12 SECTION 1. Section 130.168, Education Code, is amended to
1-13 read as follows:
1-14 Sec. 130.168. BLINN JUNIOR [~~COUNTY~~] COLLEGE DISTRICT
1-15 SERVICE AREA. The service area of the Blinn College District
1-16 includes the territory within:
1-17 (1) Washington, Burleson, Brazos, Madison, Grimes,
1-18 Waller, Lee, and Fayette counties;
1-19 (2) the Mumford, Hearne, and Franklin independent
1-20 school districts located in Robertson County;
1-21 (3) [~~the Bellville Independent School District~~
1-22 ~~located in~~] Austin County, other than the territory within the
1-23 Wallis-Orchard Independent School District;
1-24 (4) the Milano and Gause independent school districts
1-25 located in Milam County;
1-26 (5) the part of the Richards Independent School
1-27 District that is located in Walker and Montgomery counties; and
1-28 (6) the part of the Bryan Independent School District
1-29 that is located in Robertson County.
1-30 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies
1-31 beginning with the 2005 fall semester.
1-32 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-33 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-34 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-35 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-36 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
