A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to creation of a volunteer income tax assistance pilot
- 3 program for persons who owe delinquent child support.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 402, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 402.031 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 402.031. VOLUNTEER INCOME TAX ASSISTANCE PILOT
- 8 PROGRAM. (a) In this section:
- 9 (1) "Child support obligor" means a person who owes
- 10 child support arrearages.
- 11 (2) "Volunteer income tax assistance program" means
- 12 the program operated through a collaboration of the Internal
- 13 Revenue Service, the City of San Antonio, and other entities under
- 14 which low-income and other eligible taxpayers receive free
- 15 assistance in preparing federal income tax returns.
- 16 (b) The attorney general shall establish a pilot program in
- 17 San Antonio under which a child support obligor who is eligible for
- 18 <u>assistance from the volunteer income tax assistance program is</u>
- 19 encouraged to seek that assistance in order to maximize the amount
- of any tax refund to which the obligor may be entitled.
- 21 (c) The attorney general shall publicize the pilot program
- 22 using all available methods.
- 23 <u>(d) Not later than December 1, 2007, the attorney general</u>
- 24 shall submit a report to the legislature that:

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1	(1) describes the operation of the pilot program;
2	(2) analyzes the effect of the pilot program on
3	increasing the amount of money available to obligors to be used in
4	paying child support arrearages; and
5	(3) makes recommendations regarding continuation or
6	expansion of the pilot program.
7	(e) This section expires September 1, 2009.

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8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
