3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 441, Government Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 441.1035 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 441.1035. MAILED STATE PUBLICATIONS; NOTICE; ONLINE
7	AVAILABILITY. (a) A state agency that mails a state publication
8	shall make the publication accessible in an electronic format from
9	the agency's Internet website. If the agency does not have a
10	website, the agency shall deposit the electronic source file for
11	the publication in the manner prescribed by commission rules.
12	(b) When mailing a state publication, a state agency that
13	makes the publication accessible on its Internet website must
14	inform each recipient of the publication that the recipient may,
15	instead of receiving a mailed copy, access the publication at the
16	agency's Internet website.
17	(c) If a recipient prefers to access a publication at the
18	state agency's Internet website and notifies the agency of that
19	<pre>preference, the agency shall:</pre>
20	(1) remove the recipient from the mailing list for
21	that publication; and
22	(2) notify the recipient electronically each time the

publication becomes available at the agency's Internet website and

provide an electronic link to the publication.
