- 5 SECTION 1. Section 105.01(a), Alcoholic Beverage Code, is

- 7 (a) Except as provided in Sections 105.02, 105.03, [and]
- 8 105.04, and 105.08 of this code, no person may sell, offer for sale,
- 9 or deliver any liquor:
- 10 (1) on New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day, or Christmas
- 11 Day;
- 12 (2) on Sunday; or
- 13 (3) before 10 a.m. or after 9 p.m. on any other day.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 105.06, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- amended by amending Subsections (b) and (c) and adding Subsection
- 16 (f) to read as follows:
- (b) Except as provided by Subsection (f), in $[\frac{1}{1}]$ a standard
- 18 hours area, a person commits an offense if he consumes or possesses
- 19 with intent to consume an alcoholic beverage in a public place at
- 20 any time on Sunday between 1:15 a.m. and 12 noon or on any other day
- 21 between 12:15 a.m. and 7 a.m.
- 22 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (f), in [In] an
- 23 extended hours area, a person commits an offense if he consumes or
- 24 possesses with intent to consume an alcoholic beverage in a public

- 1 place at any time on Sunday between 2:15 a.m. and 12 noon and on any
- 2 other day between 2:15 a.m. and 7 a.m.
- 3 <u>(f) A person may consume or possess alcoholic beverages in a</u>
- 4 hotel bar, as defined by Section 105.08, at any time.
- 5 SECTION 3. Chapter 105, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 105.08 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 105.08. HOURS OF SALE; HOTEL BAR. (a) In this
- 8 <u>section</u>, "hotel bar" means an establishment that is located in a
- 9 hotel and holds a permit or license providing for the on-premises
- 10 consumption of alcoholic beverages.
- 11 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, a hotel bar may sell or
- offer for sale alcoholic beverages at any time.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
