- 6 SECTION 1. Section 8.07(c), Penal Code, is amended to read
- 7 as follows:
- (c) No person may, in any case, be punished by death for an 8
- offense committed while the person $[\frac{he}{e}]$ was younger than 18 $[\frac{17}{e}]$ 9
- 10 years.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 11
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 13
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- Act takes effect September 1, 2005. 15
