Sections 21.405(a) and (c), Education Code, are 4 5 amended to read as follows: (a) Except as provided by Subsection (c), each classroom 6 teacher, full-time school nurse, or full-time librarian is entitled 7 to at least a 30-minute lunch period free from all duties and 8 responsibilities connected with the instruction and supervision of 9 Each school district may set flexible or rotating 10 students. schedules for each classroom teacher, full-time school nurse, or 11 full-time librarian in the district for the implementation of the 12 duty-free lunch period. 13 14 (c) If necessary because of a personnel shortage, extreme economic conditions, or an unavoidable or unforeseen circumstance, 15 a school district may require a classroom teacher, nurse, or 16

16 a school district may require a classroom teacher, <u>nurse</u>, or 17 librarian entitled to a duty-free lunch to supervise students 18 during lunch. A classroom teacher<u>, nurse</u>, or librarian may not be 19 required to supervise students under this subsection more than one 20 day in any school week. The commissioner by rule shall prescribe 21 guidelines for determining what constitutes a personnel shortage, 22 extreme economic conditions, or an unavoidable or unforeseen 23 circumstance for purposes of this subsection.
