- 8 that transports students in connection with school activities
- 9 shall, to the extent practicable, locate each bus stop or other
- 10 place designated as a place of entry to or exit from a district
- 11 transit vehicle at least 1,000 feet from the residence of a person
- 12 who is:
- 13 (1) required to register as a sex offender under
- 14 Chapter 62, Code of Criminal Procedure, because of conduct
- involving a victim younger than 17 years of age; or
- (2) civilly committed as a sexually violent predator
- 17 under Chapter 841, Health and Safety Code, and subject to
- outpatient treatment and supervision under that chapter.
- 19 (b) The distance described by Subsection (a) must be
- 20 measured in a straight line from the nearest property line of the
