6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 67, Education Code, is

amended by adding Section 67.03 to read as follows:

9 Sec. 67.03. CAMPUS PEACE OFFICERS: CONCURRENT

JURISDICTION. (a) Campus peace officers commissioned by the

university have the same jurisdiction, powers, privileges, and

immunities as provided by Section 51.203.

(b) Subsection (a) does not in any manner limit or reduce

14 the jurisdiction, powers, privileges, and immunities provided by

law for a law enforcement agency of the state or a political

subdivision of the state, including the City of Austin police

department, with territorial jurisdiction that includes all or part

of the university campus. The law enforcement agency retains the

autonomous authority to deploy agency personnel on university

property and in university facilities in any manner consistent with

the jurisdiction, powers, privileges, and immunities of the agency.

22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
