The change in law made by this Act applies only 1-33 to a claim for unemployment compensation benefits that is filed 1-34 with the Texas Workforce Commission on or after the effective date 1-35 of this Act. A claim filed before that date is governed by the law 1-36 in effect on the date the claim was filed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 1-37 1-38 SECTION 4.
