A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the prosecution and punishment of the offense of 3 criminal trespass.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 30.05(b), Penal Code, is amended by 6 adding Subdivision (7) to read as follows:
- 7 (7) "Residential land" means real property improved by
 8 a dwelling and zoned for or otherwise authorized for single-family
- 9 or multi-family use.
- SECTION 2. Section 30.05, Penal Code, is amended by amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:
- (d) An offense under Subsection (e) is a Class C misdemeanor unless it is committed in a habitation or unless the actor carries a
- 15 deadly weapon on or about the actor's person during the commission
- of the offense, in which event it is a Class A misdemeanor. \underline{An}
- offense under Subsection (g) is a Class C misdemeanor unless it is
- committed in a building or habitation or unless the actor carries a
- 19 <u>deadly weapon on or about the actor's person during the commission</u>
- 20 <u>of the offense, in which event it is a Class A misdemeanor.</u> An
- 21 offense under Subsection (a) is a Class B misdemeanor, except that
- 22 the offense is a Class A misdemeanor if:
- 23 (1) the offense is committed:
- 24 (A) in a habitation or a shelter center; or

- 1 (B) on a Superfund site; or
- 2 (2) the actor carries a deadly weapon on or about his
- 3 person during the commission of the offense.
- 4 (g) A person commits an offense if without express consent
- 5 or if without authorization provided by any law, whether in writing
- 6 or other form, the person:
- 7 (1) enters or remains on residential land of another;
- 8 and
- 9 (2) had notice that the entry was forbidden or
- 10 received notice to depart but failed to do so.
- 11 SECTION 3. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this
- 13 Act. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed before
- 14 the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs
- 15 before the effective date.
- 16 (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this
- 17 Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed,
- 18 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 19 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
