- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 25.0742(a), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) In addition to the jurisdiction provided by Section
- 8 25.0003 and other law, a county court at law in Erath County has
- 9 concurrent jurisdiction with the district court in:
- 10 <u>(1) civil cases in which the matter in controversy</u>
- exceeds \$500 but does not exceed \$500,000, excluding interest,
- 12 statutory or punitive damages and penalties, and attorney's fees
- and costs, as alleged on the face of the petition; and
- 14 (2) family law cases and proceedings [under Chapter
- 15 262, Family Code, in which the Department of Protective and
- 16 Regulatory Services has assumed the care, custody, and control of a
- 17 child].
- SECTION 2. The change in law made to Section 25.0742(a),
- 19 Government Code, by this Act applies only to an action filed in a
- 20 statutory county court of Erath County on or after the effective
- 21 date of this Act. An action filed in a statutory county court of
- 22 Erath County before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 23 the law in effect on the date the action was filed, and the former
- law is continued in effect for that purpose.
