4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 545, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 545.0653 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 545.0653. RESTRICTION ON USE OF LEFT LANE BY CERTAIN
8	VEHICLES. (a) This section applies only to a vehicle or
9	combination of vehicles that:
10	(1) has a total of 18 wheels or more; and
11	(2) is on a highway that:
12	(A) is in the designated state highway system;
13	(B) is designated a controlled access facility;
14	and
15	(C) has a minimum of three travel lanes,
16	excluding access or frontage roads, in each direction of traffic.
17	(b) An operator of a vehicle or combination of vehicles to
18	which this section applies may not drive in the lane farthest to the
19	left unless:
20	(1) doing so is necessary to enter or exit the highway;
21	or
22	(2) only that lane is available for travel because of:
23	(A) construction or maintenance activity; or
24	(B) emergency or incident management.

1	(c) The Texas Department of Transportation shall erect and
2	maintain official traffic control devices necessary to implement
3	and enforce this section. A restriction imposed by Subsection (b)
4	may not be enforced until the appropriate traffic control devices
5	are in place.
6	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
