4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 26, Education Code, is amended by adding
6	Section 26.0101 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 26.0101. NOTICE OF SUPPLEMENTAL PRESENTATIONS. (a)
8	school district shall provide written notice to each parent of a
9	student enrolled in the district of any presentation or
10	instructional program to be presented to the student by a person not
11	regularly employed by the district. For purposes of this section, a
12	substitute teacher is considered to be regularly employed by the
13	district.
14	(b) A school district shall send notice not later than the
15	fifth working day before the presentation or instructional program.
16	The notice must include:

- (1) a description of the presentation or program; and
- 18 (2) the name and any professional affiliation of the
- 19 person making the presentation or providing the program.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2005-2006 21 school year.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
