4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. The heading to Section 61.004, Election Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	Sec. 61.004. UNLAWFUL OPERATION OF SOUND AMPLIFICATION
8	DEVICE OR SOUND TRUCK.
9	SECTION 2. Section 61.004(a), Election Code, is amended to
10	read as follows:
11	(a) A person commits an offense if, during the voting period
12	and within 1,000 feet of a building in which a polling place is
13	located, the person operates <u>a sound amplification device or</u> a
14	vehicle with a loudspeaker while the <u>device or</u> loudspeaker is being
15	used for the purpose of:
16	(1) making a political speech; or
17	(2) electioneering for or against any candidate,
18	measure, or political party.
19	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
