A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to minimum personal leave for faculty members at public
- 3 institutions of higher education.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 51.9615 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 51.9615. MINIMUM PERSONAL LEAVE FOR HIGHER EDUCATION
- 8 FACULTY. (a) In this section:
- 9 (1) "Faculty member" has the meaning assigned by
- 10 Section 51.101.
- 11 (2) "Institution of higher education" has the meaning
- 12 assigned by Section 61.003.
- 13 (b) The governing board of each institution of higher
- 14 education shall adopt a policy permitting faculty members to use
- 15 five sick leave days as personal leave days in each academic year.
- 16 In the policy, the governing board may permit faculty members to use
- 17 more than five sick leave days as personal leave days in each
- 18 <u>academic year.</u> A faculty member may not use sick leave as personal
- 19 leave during an academic year if at any time during that academic
- 20 year the total number of sick leave days available to the faculty
- 21 member falls below 20.
- (c) A policy adopted by the governing board of an
- 23 institution of higher education under this section may regulate a
- 24 <u>faculty member's use of sick leave as personal leave if the policy</u>

- does not restrict the purposes for which the personal leave may be
- 2 used.
- 3 (d) The governing board shall develop an appropriate form
- 4 for the use of sick leave days as personal leave days.
- 5 (e) A faculty member may not carry forward from one academic
- 6 year to the next unused accumulated personal leave to which the
- 7 <u>faculty member is entitled under a policy adopted under this</u>
- 8 section.
- 9 (f) The faculty member and the institution of higher
- 10 <u>education shall make every reasonable effort to provide without</u>
- 11 additional expense to the institution comparable instruction for
- 12 any classes the faculty member may miss while taking personal leave
- 13 under this section. The institution shall adopt a policy for
- 14 recovering from the faculty member any expense incurred by the
- 15 <u>institution</u> as a result of the faculty member's personal leave
- 16 <u>under this section.</u>
- 17 (g) This section does not apply to an institution of higher
- 18 education that adopts a comprehensive leave policy for faculty
- members and other employees as permitted by Section 51.961.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2005-2006
- 21 academic year.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
