A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to a project of a development corporation in connection
- 3 with a military base or facility.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2(11), Development Corporation Act of
- 6 1979 (Article 5190.6, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (11) $[\frac{A}{A}]$ "Project" shall mean the land, buildings,
- 9 equipment, facilities, expenditures, targeted infrastructure, and
- 10 improvements (one or more) that are for the creation or retention of
- 11 primary jobs and that are found by the board of directors to be
- 12 required or suitable for the development, retention, or expansion
- 13 of manufacturing and industrial facilities, research and
- 14 development facilities, military facilities, transportation
- 15 facilities (including but not limited to airports, ports, mass
- 16 commuting facilities, and parking facilities), sewage or solid
- 17 waste disposal facilities, recycling facilities, air or water
- 18 pollution control facilities, facilities for the furnishing of
- 19 water to the general public, distribution centers, small warehouse
- 20 facilities capable of serving as decentralized storage and
- 21 distribution centers, primary job training facilities for use by
- 22 institutions of higher education, and regional or national
- 23 corporate headquarters facilities.
- 24 "Project" also includes job training required or

- 1 suitable for the promotion of development and expansion of business
- 2 enterprises and other enterprises described by this Act, as
- 3 provided by Section 38 of this Act.
- 4 "Project" also includes expenditures found by the board
- 5 of directors to be required or suitable for infrastructure
- 6 necessary to promote or develop new or expanded business
- 7 enterprises limited to streets and roads, rail spurs, water and
- 8 electric utilities, gas utilities, drainage and related
- 9 improvements, and telecommunications and Internet improvements.
- 10 "Project" also includes the infrastructure,
- 11 improvements, land acquisition, buildings, or expenditures that
- 12 are found by the board of directors to be required or suitable for:
- 13 (A) promoting or supporting a military base in
- 14 active use to prevent the possible future closure or realignment of
- 15 the base;
- 16 (B) attracting new military missions to a
- 17 military base in active use; or
- 18 (C) redeveloping a military base that has been
- 19 closed or realigned, including a military base closed or realigned
- 20 pursuant to the recommendation of the Defense Base Closure and
- 21 Realignment Commission under the Defense Base Closure and
- 22 Realignment Act of 1990 (10 U.S.C. Section 2687 note).
- SECTION 2. Section 2(17), Development Corporation Act of

8 SECTION 3. Section 23(b), Development Corporation Act of 9 1979 (Article 5190.6, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to

(b) The corporation shall not have the power to own or

10 read as follows:

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operate any project as a business other than as lessor, seller, or lender or pursuant to the requirements of any trust agreement securing the credit transaction. Accordingly, the user pursuant to any lease, sale, or loan agreement relating to a project shall be considered to be the owner of the project for the purposes of the application of any ad valorem, sales, and use taxes or any other taxes levied or imposed by this state or any political subdivision of this state. The purchase and holding of mortgages, deeds of trust, or other security interests and contracting for any servicing thereof shall not be deemed the operation of a project. The corporation shall, however, have all powers necessary to own and operate a project as a business if the project is a military installation or military facility that has been closed or realigned, including a military installation or facility closed or realigned pursuant to the Defense Base Closure and Realignment Act of 1990 (10 U.S.C. Section 2687 note) as amended.

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SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
