1-9 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-10 AN ACT

1-11 relating to a project of a development corporation in connection  
1-12 with a primary job.

1-13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-14 SECTION 1. Section 2(17), Development Corporation Act of  
1-15 1979 (Article 5190.6, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to  
1-16 read as follows:

1-17 (17) "Primary job" means a job that is:

1-18 (A) available at a company for which a majority  
1-19 of the products or services of that company are ultimately exported  
1-20 to regional, statewide, national, or international markets  
1-21 infusing new dollars into the local economy; and

1-22 (B) included in one of the following sectors of  
1-23 the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS):

1-48 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-49 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-50 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-51 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-52 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.

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
