A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the system benefit fund and to eligibility for and
- 3 enrollment for benefits under the fund.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 39.903(a), Utilities Code, as amended by
- 6 Chapters 211 and 1296, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular
- Session, 2003, is reenacted and amended to read as follows: 7
- (a) The system benefit fund is an account in the general 8
- revenue fund. Money in the account may be appropriated only for the 9
- purposes provided by this section [or other law]. Interest earned 10
- 11 on the system benefit fund shall be credited to the fund. Section
- 12 403.095, Government Code, does not apply to the system benefit
- 13 fund.
- SECTION 2. Section 39.903(e), Utilities Code, as amended by 14
- Chapters 1394, 1451, and 1466, Acts of the 77th Legislature, 15
- Regular Session, 2001, is reenacted and amended to read as follows: 16
- (e) Money in the system benefit fund may be appropriated to 17
- 18 provide funding solely for the following [regulatory] purposes,
- [and] in the following order of priority: 19
- (1) programs to assist low-income electric customers 20
- 21 by providing the 10 to 20 percent reduced rate prescribed by
- 22 Subsection (h);
- 23 (2) customer education programs, administrative
- 24 expenses incurred by the commission in implementing

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- 1 administering this chapter, and expenses incurred by the office
- 2 under this chapter;
- 3 (3) programs to assist low-income electric customers
- 4 by providing the targeted energy efficiency programs described by
- 5 Subsection (f)(2); and
- 6 (4) the school funding loss mechanism provided by
- 7 Section 39.901 [+
- 8 [(5) programs to assist low-income electric customers
- 9 by providing the 20 percent reduced rate prescribed by Subsection
- 10 (h); and
- 11 [(6) reimbursement to the commission and the Texas
- 12 Department of Human Services for expenses incurred in the
- 13 implementation and administration of an integrated eligibility
- 14 process created under Section 17.007 for customer service discounts
- 15 relating to retail electric service, including outreach expenses
- 16 the commission determines are reasonable and necessary].
- SECTION 3. Section 39.903, Utilities Code, is amended by
- 18 adding Subsection (e-1) to read as follows:
- 19 (e-1) In addition to the purposes and priorities provided by
- 20 Subsection (e), the commission may use money from the system
- 21 benefit fund to educate residential and small business customers of
- 22 available benefits of the fund. The purpose for which money may be
- 23 <u>used under this subsection has the same priority as the purpose</u>
- 24 prescribed by Subsection (e)(1). This subsection expires August
- 25 31, 2006.
- SECTION 4. Section 39.903(j), Utilities Code, is amended to
- 27 read as follows:

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(j) The commission shall adopt rules providing for methods of enrolling customers eligible to receive reduced rates under Subsection (h). The rules must provide for automatic enrollment as one enrollment option. The Health and Human Services Commission [Texas Department of Human Services], on request of the commission, shall assist in the adoption and implementation of these rules. The commission and the Health and Human Services Commission [Texas Department of Human Services | shall enter into a memorandum of understanding establishing the respective duties of the agencies [commission and the department] in relation to the automatic The commission shall establish a goal under this enrollment. subsection of enrolling at least 95 percent of customers eligible to receive reduced rates under Subsection (h). Not later than December 1 of each even-numbered year, the commission shall estimate the total number of customers who are eligible for the reduced rates and shall compare the number of enrolled customers to that goal. If the goal has not been met, the commission shall use money from the fund that is available to the commission for administrative purposes to provide education and outreach concerning programs available under this section until the goal is met. The commission shall prepare a report each calendar quarter with information concerning the enrollment of customers eligible for the reduced rates and efforts to meet the goal prescribed by this subsection. The commission shall compile the information into an annual report to be published for public distribution not later than January 1 of each odd-numbered year. The commission shall send a copy of each quarterly and annual report to each member of the

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- legislature and the electric utility restructuring legislative 1 2 oversight committee. In estimating under this subsection the number of customers who are eligible for the reduced rates, the 3 commission shall use information provided by the Health and Human 4 Services Commission regarding persons who meet the definition of 5 6 "low-income electric customer," according to household income or participation in a program described by Subsection (1). The Health 7 and Human Services Commission shall provide the information to the 8 commission each calendar quarter. 9
- SECTION 5. Section 39.903(1), Utilities Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 12 (1) For the purposes of this section, a "low-income electric customer" is an electric customer:
- 14 (1) whose household income is not more than 125 15 percent of the federal poverty guidelines; or
- 16 (2) who:
- 17 <u>(A)</u> receives food stamps <u>or medical assistance</u> 18 from the <u>Health and Human Services Commission;</u>
- 19 (B) receives federal housing assistance; or
- 20 <u>(C) has a child enrolled in the national school</u>
 21 <u>lunch program of free or reduced-price lunches</u> [Texas Department of
 22 <u>Human Services or medical assistance from a state agency</u>
 23 <u>administering a part of the medical assistance program</u>].
- SECTION 6. The system benefit fund described by Section 39.903, Utilities Code, as amended by this Act, is re-created as a separate account in the general revenue fund, and money in the account is rededicated for the purposes described by that section.

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- 1 SECTION 7. The Public Utility Commission of Texas shall
- 2 adopt rules required by Section 39.903, Utilities Code, as amended
- 3 by this Act, not later than January 1, 2006.
- 4 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
