H.B. No. 554

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the system benefit fund and to eligibility for and 3 enrollment for benefits under the fund. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 39.903(a), Utilities Code, as amended by 6 Chapters 211 and 1296, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, is reenacted and amended to read as follows: 7 (a) The system benefit fund is an account in the general 8 revenue fund. Money in the account may be appropriated only for the 9 purposes provided by this section [or other law]. Interest earned 10 11 on the system benefit fund shall be credited to the fund. Section 12 403.095, Government Code, does not apply to the system benefit 13 fund. SECTION 2. Section 39.903(e), Utilities Code, as amended by 14 Chapters 1394, 1451, and 1466, Acts of the 77th Legislature, 15 Regular Session, 2001, is reenacted and amended to read as follows: 16 (e) Money in the system benefit fund may be appropriated to 17 18 provide funding solely for the following [regulatory] purposes, [and] in the following order of priority: 19 20 (1) programs to assist low-income electric customers

(1) programs to assist low-income electric customers
by providing the 10 to 20 percent reduced rate prescribed by
Subsection (h);

(2) customer education programs, administrativeexpenses incurred by the commission in implementing and

No. 554 administering this chapter, and expenses incurred by the office 1 2 under this chapter; 3 (3) programs to assist low-income electric customers by providing the targeted energy efficiency programs described by 4 5 Subsection (f)(2); and (4) the school funding loss mechanism provided by 6 Section 39.901 [+ 7 8 [(5) programs to assist low-income electric customers by providing the 20 percent reduced rate prescribed by Subsection 9 10 (h); and [(6) reimbursement to the commission and the Texas 11 Department of Human Services for expenses incurred in the 12 implementation and administration of an integrated eligibility 13 14 process created under Section 17.007 for customer service discounts 15 relating to retail electric service, including outreach expenses the commission determines are reasonable and necessary]. 16 17 SECTION 3. Section 39.903, Utilities Code, is amended by adding Subsection (e-1) to read as follows: 18 19 (e-1) In addition to the purposes and priorities provided by Subsection (e), the commission may use money from the system 20 21 benefit fund to educate residential and small business customers of available benefits of the fund. The purpose for which money may be 22 used under this subsection has the same priority as the purpose 23 prescribed by Subsection (e)(1). This subsection expires August 24 31, 2006. 25 SECTION 4. Section 39.903(j), Utilities Code, is amended to 26

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read as follows:

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(j) The commission shall adopt rules providing for methods 1 2 of enrolling customers eligible to receive reduced rates under Subsection (h). The rules must provide for automatic enrollment as 3 4 one enrollment option. The Health and Human Services Commission 5 [Texas Department of Human Services], on request of the commission, 6 shall assist in the adoption and implementation of these rules. The commission and the Health and Human Services Commission [Texas 7 8 Department of Human Services] shall enter into a memorandum of 9 understanding establishing the respective duties of the agencies [commission and the department] in relation to the automatic 10 The commission shall establish a goal under this 11 enrollment. subsection of enrolling at least 95 percent of customers eligible 12 to receive reduced rates under Subsection (h). Not later than 13 December 1 of each even-numbered year, the commission shall 14 15 estimate the total number of customers who are eligible for the reduced rates and shall compare the number of enrolled customers to 16 17 that goal. If the goal has not been met, the commission shall use money from the fund that is available to the commission for 18 administrative purposes to provide education and outreach 19 concerning programs available under this section until the goal is 20 21 met. The commission shall prepare a report each calendar quarter with information concerning the enrollment of customers eligible 22 for the reduced rates and efforts to meet the goal prescribed by 23 24 this subsection. The commission shall compile the information into an annual report to be published for public distribution not later 25 26 than January 1 of each odd-numbered year. The commission shall send 27 a copy of each quarterly and annual report to each member of the

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H.B. No. 554 legislature and the electric utility restructuring legislative 1 2 oversight committee. In estimating under this subsection the number of customers who are eligible for the reduced rates, the 3 commission shall use information provided by the Health and Human 4 Services Commission regarding persons who meet the definition of 5 6 "low-income electric customer," according to household income or participation in a program described by Subsection (1). The Health 7 and Human Services Commission shall provide the information to the 8 9 commission each calendar quarter. SECTION 5. Section 39.903(1), Utilities Code, is amended to 10 read as follows: 11 For the purposes of this section, a "low-income electric 12 (1)customer" is an electric customer: 13 14 (1) whose household income is not more than 125 15 percent of the federal poverty guidelines; or in wh<u>ose household resides a person</u> who: 16 (2) 17 (A) receives food stamps or medical assistance from the Health and Human Services Commission; 18 19 (B) receives federal housing assistance; or (C) has a child enrolled in the national school 20 21 lunch program of free or reduced-price lunches [Texas Department of Human Services or medical assistance from a state agency 22 administering a part of the medical assistance program]. 23 24 SECTION 6. The system benefit fund described by Section 25 39.903, Utilities Code, as amended by this Act, is re-created as a separate account in the general revenue fund, and money in the 26 account is rededicated for the purposes described by that section. 27

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1 SECTION 7. The Public Utility Commission of Texas shall 2 adopt rules required by Section 39.903, Utilities Code, as amended 3 by this Act, not later than January 1, 2006.

4 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
