## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the number of administrators employed by a school
3	district and the salaries paid to those persons.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 11, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 11.204 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 11.204. TEACHER/ADMINISTRATOR RATIOS; SALARY LIMIT.
8	(a) In this section:
9	(1) "Administrator" means a school district employee,
LO	other than a classroom teacher or direct student service provider,
L1	who:
L2	(A) holds at least a bachelor's degree; and
L3	(B) earns an annual salary of more than \$40,000.
L4	(2) "Direct student service provider" means:
L5	(A) a librarian assigned to a campus;
L6	(B) a nurse assigned to a campus; or
L7	(C) a certified counselor.
L8	(b) A school district may not employ a number of
L9	administrators that exceeds a ratio of one administrator for each
20	nine classroom teachers employed by the district.
21	(b-1) Subsection (b) applies beginning with the 2009-2010
22	school year. For the 2006-2007, 2007-2008, and 2008-2009 school
23	years, a school district may not employ a number of administrators
24	that exceeds the following average ratios:

- 1 (1) for the 2006-2007 and 2007-2008 school years, one
- 2 administrator for each seven classroom teachers employed by the
- 3 district; and
- 4 (2) for the 2008-2009 school year, one administrator
- 5 for each eight classroom teachers employed by the district.
- 6 (b-2) Subsection (c) applies to the computation of a ratio
- 7 under Subsection (b-1). Subsection (b-1) and this subsection
- 8 expire January 1, 2010.
- 9 (c) For purposes of Subsection (b):
- 10 (1) the principal and one assistant principal at each
- 11 campus in the district are considered to be direct student service
- 12 providers;
- 13 (2) an administrator who teaches one or more classes
- 14 is counted as one-half an administrator and is not counted as a
- 15 <u>classroom teacher; and</u>
- 16 (3) a direct student service provider is not counted
- 17 as either a classroom teacher or an administrator unless the person
- is also a classroom teacher, in which event the person is counted as
- 19 a classroom teacher.
- 20 (d) A school district may not pay an administrator a salary
- 21 that exceeds five times the amount of the lowest salary the district
- 22 pays a full-time classroom teacher.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
