A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the placement of traps, deer stands, hunting blinds, 3 wildlife feeders, and other hunting devices. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 62, Parks and Wildlife 5 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 62.002 to read as follows: Sec. 62.002. CERTAIN PLACEMENT OF HUNTING DEVICES 7 PROHIBITED. (a) In this section, "hunting blind" means a temporary 8 9 or permanent structure designed to wholly or partly conceal a person from view while the person hunts. 10 11 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), a person may not 12 place or build a hunting device, including a trap, deer stand, 13 hunting blind, or wildlife feeder, less than 200 feet from a line 14 that separates property owned by one person from property owned by another person. 15 (c) This section does not apply to a landowner who possesses 16 a written agreement with an adjoining landowner that allows the 17 18 placement of a hunting device described by Subsection (b) less than 200 feet from a common boundary shared by the landowners. 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005. 20
