- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 292, Local Government
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 292.030 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 292.030. FACILITIES IN UNINCORPORATED AREA OF COUNTY.
- 8 (a) The commissioners court of a county may purchase, construct,
- 9 reconstruct, improve, equip, or provide for by other means,
- 10 including by lease or lease with an option to purchase, a branch
- office in the unincorporated area of the county.
- 12 (b) Any county officer may maintain an office and the county
- 13 may provide any county service at the branch office authorized by
- 14 this section. The maintenance of an office or the provision of a
- 15 service at the branch office must be in addition to an office
- 16 maintained or service provided at any other location required by
- 17 law.

- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
