- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 45.201(2), Education Code, as amended by
- 5 Chapters 62 and 344, Acts of the 76th Legislature, Regular Session,
- 6 1999, is reenacted to read as follows:
- 7 (2) "Bank" means a bank, a savings and loan
- 8 association, or a savings bank organized under the laws of this
- 9 state, another state, or federal law that has its main office or a
- 10 branch office in this state. The term does not include any bank the
- 11 deposits of which are not insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance
- 12 Corporation.
- SECTION 2. Section 45.201(4), Education Code, is amended to
- 14 read as follows:
- 15 (4) "Approved securities" means:
- 16 (A) bonds of this state or any agency or
- 17 political subdivision of this state;
- 18 (B) all evidences of indebtedness legally issued
- 19 by the board of trustees of the depositing school district;
- 20 (C) all debt securities that are a direct
- 21 obligation of the treasury of the United States;
- 22 (D) [other obligations, including] reducing
- 23 principal balance securities, the principal and interest of which
- 24 are unconditionally guaranteed or insured by, or backed by the full

- 1 faith and credit of, this state or the United States or their
- 2 respective agencies and instrumentalities; [and]
- 3 (E) other obligations, the principal and
- 4 interest of which are unconditionally guaranteed or insured by, or
- 5 backed by the full faith and credit of, this state or the United
- 6 States or their respective agencies and instrumentalities; and
- 7 (F) those securities provided for by Article 842,
- 8 Revised Statutes, and Section 1, Chapter 160, General Laws, Acts of
- 9 the 43rd Legislature, 1933 (Article 842a, Vernon's Texas Civil
- 10 Statutes).
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
