## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to liquidated damages for violating certain requirements
- 3 relating to executory contracts for the conveyance of certain real
- 4 property.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 5.077(c), Property Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (c) A seller who fails to comply with Subsection (a) is
- 9 liable to the purchaser for:
- 10 (1) liquidated damages in the amount of \$250 [a day]
- 11 for each annual statement [day after January 31 that] the seller
- 12 fails to provide to the purchaser within the time required by
- 13 <u>Subsection (a)</u> [with the statement]; and
- 14 (2) reasonable attorney's fees.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to the act of a seller who fails to timely provide an annual
- 17 statement as required by Section 5.077(a), Property Code, on or
- 18 after the effective date of this Act. The act of a seller who fails
- 19 to timely provide an annual statement as required by Section
- 20 5.077(a), Property Code, before the effective date of this Act is
- 21 covered by the law in effect when the act was committed, and the
- 22 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
