- 5 SECTION 1. Section 37.007, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (a) A student shall be expelled from a school if the
- 9 student, on school property or while attending a school-sponsored
- 10 or school-related activity on or off of school property:
- 11 (1) except as provided by Subsection (a-1) or (e),
- 12 intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly uses, exhibits, or
- 13 possesses:
- 14 (A) a firearm as defined by Section 46.01(3),
- 15 Penal Code;
- 16 (B) an illegal knife as defined by Section
- 17 46.01(6), Penal Code, or by local policy;
- 18 (C) a club as defined by Section 46.01(1), Penal
- 19 Code; or
- 20 (D) a weapon listed as a prohibited weapon under
- 21 Section 46.05, Penal Code;
- 22 (2) engages in conduct that contains the elements of
- 23 the offense of:
- 24 (A) aggravated assault under Section 22.02,

- 1 Penal Code, sexual assault under Section 22.011, Penal Code, or
- 2 aggravated sexual assault under Section 22.021, Penal Code;
- 3 (B) arson under Section 28.02, Penal Code;
- 4 (C) murder under Section 19.02, Penal Code,
- 5 capital murder under Section 19.03, Penal Code, or criminal
- 6 attempt, under Section 15.01, Penal Code, to commit murder or
- 7 capital murder;
- 8 (D) indecency with a child under Section 21.11,

- 25 SECTION 2. Section 37.007(a), Education Code, as amended by

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
