- 5 SECTION 1. PARTICIPATION OF CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS EMPLOYED
- 6 AFTER ENACTMENT OF CHAPTER 1231, ACTS OF THE 77TH LEGISLATURE,
- 7 REGULAR SESSION, 2001. Notwithstanding Section 1551.102, Insurance
- 8 Code, or any other law, an individual is eligible to participate as
- 9 an annuitant in the group benefits program under Chapter 1551,
- 10 Insurance Code, if:
- 11 (1) the individual was initially employed on or after
- 12 September 1, 2001, but before September 10, 2001, by a school
- 13 district that operates schools at facilities of the Texas
- 14 Department of Criminal Justice for the education of persons
- 15 confined or imprisoned in those facilities;
- 16 (2) the individual is continuously employed by that
- 17 school district until September 1, 2005, or a later date; and
- 18 (3) on the date the individual seeks to participate as
- 19 an annuitant, the individual would be eligible to participate as an
- 20 annuitant under former Section 3(a)(2), Texas Employees Uniform
- 21 Group Insurance Benefits Act (Article 3.50-2, Vernon's Texas
- 22 Insurance Code), as that section existed immediately before
- 23 amendment by Section 27, Chapter 1231, Acts of the 77th
- 24 Legislature, Regular Session, 2001.
