## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

H.B. No. 608

1 AN ACT

2 relating to school district internship programs in which students

3 earn credit for high school graduation by working with elected

4 government officials.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 28.002(f), Education Code, is amended to

7 read as follows:

- 8 (f) In addition to courses in the required curriculum, a [A]
- 9 school district may offer courses for local credit, including an

10 internship program in which a student works with an elected local,

- 11 state, or national government official under the supervision of a
- 12 <u>classroom teacher from the student's school</u>. The State Board of
- 13 Education shall permit course credit earned through an internship
- 14 program described by this subsection to be used to comply with
- 15 appropriate state elective course credit requirements for high
- 16 school graduation [in addition to those in the required
- 17 curriculum]. The State Board of Education shall be flexible in
- 18 approving <u>any other</u> [a] course for <u>local</u> credit for high school
- 19 graduation under this subsection.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
