Section 264.101, Family Code, is amended by 4 5 adding Subsection (a-1) and amending Subsection (d) to read as follows: 6 (a-1) The department shall continue to pay the cost of 7 foster care for a child for whom the department provides care, 8 including medical care, after the child becomes 18 years of age if 9 the child is enrolled in an accredited secondary school in a program 10 11 leading toward a high school diploma. 12 (d) The executive commissioner of the Health and Human 13 Services Commission [Board of Protective and Regulatory Services] 14 may adopt rules that establish criteria and guidelines for the payment of foster care, including medical care, for a child and for 15 providing care for a child after the child becomes 18 years of age 16 if the child is regularly attending [high school,] an institution 17

18 of higher education $[-\tau]$ or a vocational or technical program.

19 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 20 to a child who is in foster care on or after the effective date of 21 this Act.

22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
