A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to contributions of certain members of the Judicial  
3 Retirement System of Texas Plan Two.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 840.102, Government Code, is amended by  
6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (h) to read as  
7 follows:

8 (a) Except as provided by Subsections [~~Subsection~~] (g) and  
9 (h), each payroll period, a judicial officer who is a member of the  
10 retirement system is required to contribute six percent of the  
11 officer's state compensation for the period to the retirement  
12 system.

13 (h) If a member has served at least 12 years on an appellate  
14 court and the sum of the member's age and amount of service credited  
15 in the retirement system equals or exceeds the number 70, the member  
16 ceases making contributions under this section. A member described  
17 by this subsection is considered a contributing member for all  
18 other purposes under this subtitle.

19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
