- 3 Charitable Raffle Enabling Act to conduct a reverse raffle.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2002.002, Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Subdivision (7) to read as follows:
- 7 (7) "Reverse raffle" means a raffle in which the last
- 8 <u>ticket or tickets drawn are considered the winning tickets.</u>
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 2002.054(c), Occupations Code, is
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- 11 (c) Except as provided by Section 2002.0541, the [The]
- 12 organization may not permit a person who is not a member of the
- organization or who is not authorized by the organization to sell or
- 14 offer to sell raffle tickets.
- SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 2002, Occupations Code, is
- amended by adding Section 2002.0541 to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 2002.0541. REVERSE RAFFLE. (a) A qualified
- 18 organization may conduct a reverse raffle as provided by this
- 19 <u>section.</u>
- 20 (b) Notwithstanding Section 2002.056(a), a refund of the
- 21 purchase price of a ticket may be awarded as a raffle prize in a
- 22 reverse raffle.
- (c) Notwithstanding Section 2002.055(3), after the drawing
- 24 of tickets in a reverse raffle has begun, the qualified

- 1 organization conducting the raffle may auction off additional
- 2 tickets to persons who are present at the drawing for a price other
- 3 than the price printed on the ticket.
- 4 (d) After the drawing of tickets in a reverse raffle has
- 5 begun, the qualified organization may permit a ticket holder
- 6 present at the drawing to resell the ticket to another person
- 7 present at the drawing for an amount greater than the original
- 8 purchase price of the ticket. The sale must be made through a
- 9 designated representative of the organization, and not less than 10
- 10 percent of the sale proceeds must be retained by the organization.
- (e) Notwithstanding Section 2002.055(3), after the drawing
- 12 of tickets in a reverse raffle has begun, the qualified
- organization may permit the holder of a previously drawn ticket:
- 14 (1) to purchase additional chances for the ticket to
- be selected to win a prize; or
- 16 (2) to purchase additional tickets for the raffle.
- 17 (f) Only the portion of the proceeds from the resale of a
- 18 <u>ticket under Subsection (d) retained by the organization are</u>
- 19 subject to Section 2002.053. All proceeds from the sale of
- 20 additional chances for a ticket under Subsection (e) are considered
- 21 to be proceeds from the sale of the ticket for purposes of Section
- 22 2002.053.
- 23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
