2	relating to the disclosure of certain convictions and judgments by
3	persons regulated by the Texas Residential Construction
4	Commission.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Chapter 409, Property Code, is amended by adding
7	Section 409.004 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 409.004. DISCLOSURE OF CONVICTIONS AND JUDGMENTS. (a)
9	Not later than the 30th day after entry of the judgment or plea, a
10	builder who holds a certificate of registration issued under this
11	title shall disclose to the commission:
12	(1) each plea of guilty or nolo contendere to a felony
13	charge, or to a misdemeanor based on conduct involving a
14	construction defect or other transaction between the builder and a
15	homeowner;
16	(2) each conviction of a felony, or of a misdemeanor
17	based on conduct involving a construction defect or other
18	transaction between the builder and a homeowner; and
19	(3) each judgment against the builder in a dispute
20	involving a construction defect or other transaction between the
21	builder and a homeowner.
22	(b) The commission shall make the disclosed information

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available to the public and shall post the information on the

commission's website. The commission shall make the information

- 1 <u>searchable by the name of the builder.</u>
- 2 SECTION 2. Section 416.002(b), Property Code, is amended to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 (b) Each applicant must disclose in the application whether
- 5 the applicant has:
- 6 (1) entered a plea of guilty or nolo contendere to a
- 7 felony charge or a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude or based
- 8 on conduct involving a construction defect or other transaction
- 9 between the applicant and a homeowner; [er]
- 10 (2) been convicted of a felony or a misdemeanor
- 11 involving moral turpitude or based on conduct involving a
- 12 construction defect or other transaction between the applicant and
- 13 a homeowner, and the time for appeal has elapsed or the conviction
- 14 has been affirmed on appeal; or
- 15 (3) been found liable on a judgment in a dispute
- 16 involving a construction defect or other transaction between the
- applicant and a homeowner.
- SECTION 3. (a) Not later than November 1, 2005, builders
- 19 regulated by the Texas Residential Construction Commission shall
- 20 disclose to the commission all information described by Section
- 21 409.004(a), Property Code, as added by this Act, that has not been
- 22 previously disclosed to the commission.
- (b) Not later than February 1, 2006, the Texas Residential
- 24 Construction Commission shall comply with Section 409.004(b),
- 25 Property Code, as added by this Act.
- SECTION 4. (a) Not later than October 1, 2005, the Texas
- 27 Residential Construction Commission shall modify the form

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- 1 prescribed for an application for a certificate under Section
- 2 416.002(a), Property Code, to comply with Section 416.002(b),
- 3 Property Code, as amended by this Act.
- 4 (b) Section 416.002(b), Property Code, as amended by this
- 5 Act, applies only to an application received by the Texas
- 6 Residential Construction Commission on or after November 1, 2005.
- 7 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
