4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 343, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 343.0115 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 343.0115. BARKING DOGS IN CERTAIN RESIDENTIAL AREAS.
8	(a) This section applies only to the unincorporated area of a
9	county with a population of 275,000 or more that is adjacent to a
10	county with a population of 3.3 million or more.
11	(b) It is a public nuisance under Section 343.011 to allow
12	the barking of or another noise made by a dog outdoors on premises

- the barking of or another noise made by a dog outdoors on premises
  in a neighborhood if a reasonable person would find the noise
  objectionable.
- 15 <u>(c) In determining whether a noise is objectionable to a</u>
  16 <u>reasonable person under this section, the following factors may be</u>
  17 considered:
  - (1) the time of day the noise is produced;
- 19 (2) the proximity of the production of the noise to 20 other premises; and
- 21 (3) whether the sound is recurrent, intermittent, or 22 constant.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
