- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 291.008(a), Local Government Code, is 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) The commissioners court may set a fee not to exceed \$10
- 7 [\$5] to be collected at the time of filing in each civil case filed
- 8 in a county court, county court at law, or district court which
- 9 shall be taxed as other costs. The county is not liable for the
- 10 costs.
- 11 SECTION 2. Article 102.017(a), Code of Criminal Procedure,
- 12 is amended to read as follows:
- 13 (a) A defendant convicted of a felony offense in a district
- court shall pay a \$10 [\$5] security fee as a cost of court.
- 15 SECTION 3. (a) This Act applies only to a civil case filed
- on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 17 (b) This Act applies in a criminal case only to a cost on
- 18 conviction for an offense committed on or after the effective date
- 19 of this Act. For purposes of this subsection, an offense is
- 20 committed before the effective date of this Act if any element of
- 21 the offense occurs before the effective date.
- (c) A cost on conviction for an offense committed before the
- 23 effective date of this Act is covered by the law in effect when the
- offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for

- 2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
