- 3 (b) A member of the work group serving under Subsection
- 4 (a)(1) or (2) is not entitled to additional compensation for
- 5 serving on the work group. Another member of the work group is not
- 6 entitled to compensation for serving on the work group.
- 7 (c) Not later than January 1, 2007, the work group shall
- 8 submit its findings to the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the
- 9 house of representatives, and the presiding officers of the
- 10 standing committees of each house with jurisdiction over assisted

- 12 (d) This section expires January 1, 2007.
