A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the registration of certain assisted living facilities.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 247, Health and Safety
5	Code, is amended by adding Section 247.032 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 247.032. REGISTRATION OF CERTAIN FACILITIES. (a) The
7	executive commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission
8	by rule shall establish a classification and registration for a
9	<pre>facility that:</pre>
10	(1) furnishes food and shelter to three or fewer
11	persons who are unrelated to the proprietor of the facility; and
12	(2) provides personal care services.
13	(b) A person may not operate a facility described by
14	Subsection (a) unless the person is registered with the department
15	as provided by this section and rules adopted under this section.
16	(c) A person may apply for registration under this section
17	by submitting:
18	(1) an application for registration on a form
19	<pre>prescribed by the department; and</pre>
20	(2) a fee of \$50.
21	(d) A registration is valid until the second anniversary of
22	the date of issuance.
23	(e) A facility registered under this section shall grant
24	reasonable access to the department and its designees to enable the

- 1 department to ensure the residents of the facility have access to
- 2 community services and benefit programs. The executive
- 3 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission by rule
- 4 may establish protocol for:
- 5 (1) inquiries and visits to a facility; and
- 6 (2) reporting instances of abuse, neglect, or
- 7 <u>exploitation observed or reported during the visits.</u>
- 8 (f) Notwithstanding Section 48.301, Human Resources Code,
- 9 or Section 247.043, the Department of Family and Protective
- 10 Services may conduct investigations of abuse, neglect, and
- 11 exploitation at facilities registered under this section in
- 12 accordance with Chapter 48, Human Resources Code.
- 13 (g) The department may deny, suspend, or revoke a
- 14 registration for a violation of this chapter or a rule adopted under
- 15 this chapter.
- (h) A person who operates a facility without a current
- 17 registration or who violates this section or a rule adopted under
- 18 this section is subject to the remedies and penalties provided by
- 19 Subchapter C as if the person held or is required to hold a license
- 20 under this subchapter.
- SECTION 2. (a) Not later than January 1, 2006, the
- 22 executive commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission
- 23 shall adopt the rules necessary to implement Section 247.032,
- 24 Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act.
- 25 (b) Notwithstanding Section 247.032, Health and Safety
- 26 Code, as added by this Act, a facility is not required to register
- with the Department of Aging and Disability Services before March

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- 1 1, 2006.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
